LESSON 1 — THE SOURCE OF PEACE

Jesus Is the Prince of Peace

- Jesus is the Prince of Peace Isa. 9:6; Eph. 2:14
- ❖ Peace comes from being in His Presence 2 Thes. 3:16; Psa. 16:11; Exo. 33:14
- We have a peace that prevails because it comes from Jesus who overcame the world John 16:33; Psa. 34:19; Rom. 8:37

A Peaceful Mind

- ❖ Our mind must stay on Him to be kept in perfect peace − Isa. 26:3; Rom. 8:6
 - Also: Phil. 4:8; Psa. 112:7-8
- ❖ It must govern me Col. 3:15; Prov. 3:5-6

Settling in His Peace

- I'm safe and secure Psa. 4:8; Psa. 91:1-2; Prov. 18:10
- ❖ I'm provided for Psa. 23:1-2; Psa. 37:25; Phil. 4:19; Mat. 6:25-27
- I'm supported and encouraged
 - > Strengthened Isa. 41:10
 - Comforted and encouraged 2 Cor. 1:3-4

Anxiety Is an Enemy of Peace

- God give us 2 keys in these verse to dealing with anxiety Phil. 4:6-7
 - Prayer Communicating with God about everything
 - Supplication Specific, earnest requests made in humility and dependence on God
 - Examples: 1 Sam. 1:10-11; Psa. 51:1-12; 2 Chro. 20:12; 2 Cor. 12:7-9; Acts 10:2-4
- ❖ Use the attack as an opportunity to turn to God Psa. 55:22; Psa. 94:18-19 (MSG); Mat. 6:25-34
- Also: 1 Pet. 5:7; Prov. 12:25

LESSON 2 — THE PEACE OF GOD & PEACE WITH GOD

The Peace of God

- ❖ God gives us peace that is not as the world John 14:27; John 20:21; Psa. 29:11
- ❖ God promises us peace Isa. 54:10; Num. 6:24-26; Isa. 32:17; Lev. 26:6

Being at Peace with God

- ❖ Difficult to have peace with others when you are not pleasing God Pro. 16:7; 1 John 3:21-22
- ❖ We must personally be at peace with God Rom. 5:11; Rom. 5:1; Col. 1:20
- God's Word speaks to those who please Him
 - Peace on earth toward those under God's favor Luk. 2:14
 - ➤ God speaks peace to those who turn their hearts toward Him Psa. 85:8

Surrendering to His Lordship

❖ We must accept and surrender to the Lordship of Jesus – Rom. 14:9; Luke 6:46; Gal. 2:20

Intentionally Pursuing Peace

❖ We must be intentional about pursuing peace – 1 Pet. 3:11; Psa. 34:14; Rom. 14:19; Heb. 12:14

Praying for Peace

- ❖ We are to pray for inner peace Phil. 4:6-7; Psa. 94:18-19 (MSG)
- ❖ We are to pray for peace in relationships Eph. 4:2-3
- ❖ We are to pray for peace in the world 1 Tim. 2:1-2
- Pray for peace where God has planted us Jer. 29:7
- ❖ We are to pray for spiritual peace Rom. 15:13; Isa. 26:12
