What is Faith?

- ❖ Faith pistis: 1) conviction of the truth of anything, belief; in the NT of a conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervour born of faith and joined with it; 2) fidelity, faithfulness, 2a) the character of one who can be relied on Thayer's Greek Definitions
- ❖ Faith: 1. complete trust or confidence in someone or something. 2. strong belief in God or in the doctrines of a religion, based on spiritual apprehension rather than proof. Oxford Languages Dictionary

Believing vs. Believing

- Believing there is a God is not enough James 2:19
- ❖ Believing in Jesus is not enough just as knowing a person doesn't mean that you know them Acts 19:13
- ❖ Believing on the finished work of Jesus Christ Eph. 2:8-9; John 3:16; Col. 2:12; 2 Cor. 5:21; Rom. 6:24

Unbelief can be Tangible

- ❖ Mark 9:24 CEV
- It limited what Jesus would do Mat. 13:3-58
- Don't believe God can be satisfied by God's way
 - Adam and Eve
 - Cleaving to one wife
 - God's role for me is not enough
- Refusing to see yourself and your assignment as God does Number 13:30-33
- Doubting God's motives Number 14:3-4
- Entertaining conversations that lead us from faith –
- Allow fear to take residence in us Number 14:9
- ❖ Adding to or feeling the need to help God Gal. 1:6-7
- Actions contrary to faith 1 Tim. 5:8

Unbelief leads to perversion – Matthew 17:17

- Perverse: diastrephō: 1) to distort, turn aside; 1a) to oppose, plot against the saving purposes and plans of God; 2) to turn aside from the right path, to pervert, corrupt
- What we see happening in the world today is the result of unbelief Psalm 14:1

What is Growing Unbelief in Me?

- Frustration with others Mark 9:18
 - Unmet expectations
- Frustration with what you are experiencing Mark 9:18
- Nothing seems to be changing Mark 9:21
- Not acknowledging that it's there Mark 9:24 CEV



What will Grow Faith and Belief in Me?

- Admit where you are at to Jesus Mark 9:24
- It's the seed
 - Mustard seed Mat. 17:20
 - Seed must be processed
 - > Don't let the size of the seed fool you of it's potential (What it looks like)
- When you learn to speak to your problems and command them according to the Word of God Mat. 17:20
- ❖ When you have place your confidence in the Lord and not your own abilities Romans 4:16-21

We must grow spiritually to discern what kind of issue and the proper solution

- Some things require a therapist
- Some things simply require a physician Luke 8:43
- But this kind by prayer and fasting Mat. 17:21
 - ➤ Kind: genos: kindred, 1a) offspring, 1b) family, 1c) stock, tribe, nation, 1c1) i.e. nationality or descent from a particular people, 1d) the aggregate of many individuals of the same nature, kind, sort

Faith in Failure

- ❖ God does not fail Heb. 1:10-12; 1 Cor. 1:9
- ❖ God knows we will make mistakes Psa. 37:23; Rom. 8:31-33
- ❖ Failure comes with reasons Isa. 59:1-2
- One of the largest reasons we fail is by trying to be self-dependent of God John 15:5
 - Create the problem with disobedience
 - > Try to solve the problem in our strength Isa. 40:29
 - Depending upon your own reasoning Pro. 3:5-6; Psa. 127:1; Rom. 12:3
 - Leads to idol worship where you make yourself the idol Pro. 27:2; Isa. 64:6; Exo 20:3; Col. 3:5-8 (KJV, MSG)
 - ➤ We look to ourselves instead of God Heb. 12:1-2; Phil 4:11-13
- Deeper failure is when we accuse ourselves with statements like:
 - > If I only had enough faith, it wouldn't have happened
 - If I only prayed more, it wouldn't have happened
 - If I had only been there, it wouldn't have happened
 - Absence is not always a reason for seeming failure John 11:1-21 (vs. 6, 21)
 - Is this the result of my sins? John 9:2
- ❖ While we don't condone sin, we must acknowledge we are in the flesh Psa. 73:26; Romans 7
 - Read Romans 6:23 (both parts a & b)
- All failure is not your responsibility Luke 9:1-5; John 15:18
- ❖ What do I do after I've failed?
 - Acknowledge it before God Pro. 28:13; Psa. 32:5-11
 - You may have to acknowledge it before others Mat. 5:23-24; James 5:13-16;
 - ➤ Repent Psa. 51:10
 - Seek the Word for the why
 - Where do you turn wrong 2 Pet. 3:17, Heb. 3:12; 2 Chr. 12:14
 - Acknowledge Christ's forgiveness 1 John 1:8-9
 - Failing to acknowledge what Christ has done is failing to believe He has done what He said He would do
 - Forgive yourself
 - ➤ Move forward depending upon the Lord 2 Cor. 5:17; Jude 1:24
- The key to faith in failure is getting up
 - ➤ It's up to us Jer. 8:4-8
 - Stop trying to keep others down when they mess up Pro. 24:15-16
- Learn from your failures
 - Don't continue the cycle Pro. 26:11;
 - Appreciate the lesson Psa. 119:71
 - Failures provoke transformation Psa. 40:2-3; Acts 19:13-20



Faith in Frustration

- What is frustration?
 - 1: the act of frustrating; 2a: the state or an instance of being frustrated; b: a deep chronic sense or state of insecurity and dissatisfaction arising from unresolved problems or unfulfilled needs

 - > The act of preventing the accomplishment or fulfillment of something. American Heritage Dictionary
- Signs of frustration (https://www.webmd.com/mental-health/signs-frustration)
 - Losing your temper
 - > Incessant bodily movement
 - > Feeling sad or anxious
 - Lacking self-confidence
 - Trouble sleeping
 - Bodily abuse, starving oneself, or irregular eating habits
- ❖ Job dealt with frustration Job 6:11, 7:3, 17:11
- ❖ Jacob's frustration Gen. 42:29-36
 - Wasn't what he expected for Joseph Gen. 37:3
- ❖ Some of us are frustrated because we are expecting fulfillment from those who can not and were never design to fulfill you 2 Tim. 1:12-14; Isa. 58:11 (KJV /MSG); Psa. 37:4; Heb. 12:2; Rom. 15:13; Phil. 4:13,19
- You can be frustrated with stuff: Ecc. 1:8, 5:10, 6:7; Isa. 55:2
- Spiritual frustration comes from many sources
 - Drinking from the wrong water John 4:13
 - ➤ Knowing there is more but lacking the spiritual discernment or capacity to realize more 1 Cor. 2:6-16
 - Not being fed by refusing to be led Psa. 23; Mat. 15:29-39
 - ➤ Not being willing to be separate 2 Tim. 2:20-22
 - Sin in the camp Joshua 7
