Part 1: Who's the Center?

Tonight's Key Passage: John 15:1-6

- ❖ **What makes pivoting possible is what you are pivoting on – John 15:1-6**
 - The expectation of being connected – John 15:2
 - Lack of productivity could indicate that you are not as connected as you think – John 15:2; Mat. 15: 13
 - The importance of being connected – John 15:4
 - Being connected brings about change
 - Pruning – John 15:2, 3
 - God uses the Word to prune us – 2 Tim. 3:16-17; John 17:17
 - ◆ It is the pruning that identifies our connection – Heb. 12:6-7; Prov. 12:1; Pro. 15:32
 - The purpose of the pruning – John 15:2; Prov. 25:4; Isa. 1:21-22 (KJV & MSG); 2 Tim. 2:20-22
 - Pruning involves more than just person but also processes and systems – Luke 5:33-39; Eph. 4:22-24; Isa. 43:19; **Luke 13:6-9 (KJV & MSG)**
 - If we are connected, God expects more – John 15:2; Mat. 13:12 (MSG)

- ❖ **When God is your constant, you can pivot on Him**
 - He does not change– Mal. 3:6; Heb. 13:8; Psa. 119:89
 - He changes us – Eph. 1:11; Eze. 36:26; 1 Cor. 6:9-11; Phil. 1:6; **Col. 3:10**; 1 John 3:2-3

- ❖ We fail because we make everything about us:
 - How I feel
 - What I want
 - What I'm comfortable with
 - What I like
 - But what does Scripture say?
 - Exo. 3:4-14; 4:13-16: Moses excuses
 - I'm not good enough – vs. 11
 - I don't know enough – vs. 14
 - How the people see me – 4:1 (3:18; 4:2-9)
 - I don't talk well – 4:10
 - I don't want to – 4:13
 - Jeremiah 1:7
 - Mat. 16:24-26

Closing scripture: Colossians 1:18

Part 2: No More Majoring in the Minor

Tonight's Key Passage: 2 Timothy 2

- ❖ **Everything in your life doesn't and shouldn't have the same weight –**
 - The importance of an item is often determined by the value ascribed to it
 - We tend to load up on the minor instead of focusing on the major

- ❖ When we know our value, it enables us to make the faith pivots that God is leading us to make
- ❖ **You can not get trapped in the minor when God is leading you into the major**

Signs of majoring in the minor:

- ❖ Constant complaining – Phil. 2:14-16; Num. 11:1-6; James 4:1-3
- ❖ Missed assignments – James 4:17
- ❖ Delayed obedience – Psa 119:60
- ❖ Greed – Luke 12:15
- ❖ Wrong Priorities – Mat 16:26
- ❖ Focusing on Abilities and Ignoring Gifts and Anointing –
- ❖ Religious practice but no depth or conviction – Mat. 23:23
- ❖ Mat. 7:6
- ❖ Poor perspective on your trials – 2 Cor. 4:7

What are some "Majors"?

- ❖ In terms of faith:
 - Faith in God – Heb. 11:1, 6
 - The Power of the Gospel – 1 Cor. 15:1-4
 - The Trinity – Mat. 28:19; Gen. 1:26
 - We are saved by Grace – Eph. 2:8-9
 - Jesus is the Way – John 14:6; Acts 4:12
 - The virgin birth – Mat. 1:18-25
 - Jesus died for our sins – Rom. 5:8; 1 Pet. 3:18
 - Jesus rose from the dead – 1 Cor. 15:14; Rom. 10:9-10
- ❖ In your life:
 - Your health (mentally, spiritually and physically)
 - Your family
 - Your legacy

How do I make this pivot?

- ❖ Know that your worth comes from God – 2 Tim. 2:1
- ❖ Make sure those you are depositing into can handle your deposits – 2 Tim. 2:2
- ❖ Stay focused on the mission – 2 Tim. 2:3-7
 - Realize that mistakes and missteps will come – Psa. 37:23-24
- ❖ In the midst of everything, rehearse your purpose – 2 Tim. 2:7-10
- ❖ Stay the course – 2 Tim. 2:10-13
- ❖ Learn to let the petty go – 2 Tim. 2:14 (MSG), 16-17
- ❖ Study – 2 Tim. 2:15; 1 Thes. 4:11(KJV & MSG)

Part 3: Pivoting to Progress

Tonight's Key Passage: Romans 12:11

- ❖ **Most of us profess to want better in life yet don't always know what better is**
 - Is it just a bigger house? Hag. 1:4; Deu. 8:11-18
 - Is it a bigger bank accounts and possessions? Luke 12:15-21
 - Is it more attention? Luke 22:24-30; Mat. 23:11-12
 - Is it a position or standing among people? Mat. 23:1-12, 15; contrast with Pro. 31:23
- ❖ **Your better may not be my better just as your giftings may not be mine** – 1 Cor. 12:4-11; Mat. 25:14-30
- ❖ **Better gets you more aligned with God's Purpose** – 3 John 2
- ❖ **It is abnormal when we don't progress** – 3 John 2
- ❖ **You can not pivot to progress and hold on to backwards thinking** – Num. 11:1-6
 - Backwards thinking will have you:
 - Thinking progress is killing you – Exo. 16:1-3
 - Herding corruptible eventual trash instead of seeking Kingdom treasures – Luke 12:16-21; 1 Pet. 1:18-20
 - Fighting your deliverer and celebrating your oppressor – Num. 16
 - Stuck in a cycle of spiritual depravity and physical poverty – Jer. 7:24 (KJV & MSG); 15:6
 - Remembering and focusing on the wrong things – Phil. 3:12-14; 1 Cor. 6:11-13
 - Unfit for the kingdom of God – Luke 9:62
 - Miss God's plan and timing for yourself and those around you – Ecc. 3:1-11
 - Stuck – Gen. 19:26
 - Looking a sugar daddy or momma instead of working Kingdom principles – Deut. 8:18; Pro. 12:11; 13:4

HOW TO PIVOT TO PROGRESS

- ❖ **Make your walk with God personal** – between you and Him – Rev. 3:20; Rev. 1:1;
 - Personal revelation will sustain you through public devastation – Heb. 11:7
 - You can't afford to wait for the crowd to understand – Mat. 26:6-13
- ❖ **Reset your mind** – Col. 3:1-2; Rom. 12:2
- ❖ **Change your confessions** – Pro. 18:4, 21; James 3:5; Phil. 4:8
 - Not I can't but I can – Phil. 4:13
 - Not I'm lacking but God's provision – Phil. 4:19
 - Not bondage but liberty – 2 Cor. 3:17
 - Not loneliness but relationship – Heb. 13:5
 - Not failure but forgiveness and restoration – Psa. 37:23-24; Psa. 73:26

Part 3: Pivoting to Progress (continued)

Moving from the dead to life...

❖ You must pivot from dead works

- It is fundamental that we know move from dead works – Heb. 6:1
- Dead works are closely tied to self-righteousness – Pro. 14:12; Pr. 16:25; Rom. 10:3
 - When we feel that our way is fine, we cannot progress.
- Dead works are signs of dead lives – Eph. 2:5
 - Dead thinking – Eph. 2:5
- You cannot serve the living God with a dead conscience – Heb. 9:14

❖ You must pivot from dead actions

- What really matters? John 13:8-11
- What's at the heart of your actions determines whether its dead – 2 Cor. 9:7; Mat. 6:1
- No more going through the motions in worship – Mat. 15:1-9 (vs. 9 in KJV and MSG)
- No more pretense – Mat. 23:14

❖ You must pivot from dead things

- Dead things can't save you – 1 Pet. 1:18; Eph. 2:5-10
- Must pivot from weight of sin – Heb. 12:1
- Must pivot from dead places – Eph. 5:8-13; Eph. 4:27-30; 2 Tim. 2:21
- Must pivot from dead spaces – Eph. 5:14-17; Mat. 16:26
- Must pivot from dead relationships – Isa. 43:18-19; 2 Cor. 6:14-18

➔STOP TRYING TO CARRY YOUR OPPRESSOR TO YOUR PROMISE

Activating the Power Within – Ephesians 3:14-21

- ❖ Vs. 16: He would grant you according to the riches of His glory – Phil. 4:19
 - To be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man – Col. 1:11-12; Rom. 7:22
- ❖ Vs. 17: That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith – John 14:23; 1 John 4:7; Rev. 3:20
 - Are you rooted and grounded in love? Col. 1:23; Eph. 2:4; 1 Cor. 13:1-13

- Vs. 20: The Doxology: Now unto Him that is able – Rom. 16:25; Isa. 59:1; Psalm 147:4-5; 1 Cor. 4:20
 - Able to do exceeding abundantly – 1 Tim. 1:14; Isa. 55:7; John 10:10

- ❖ Vs. 21: Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout ages...Rom. 11:36

Why Not Me?

❖ God is the One who chooses us – Rom. 8:30

- Called: kaleo:1) to call aloud, utter in a loud voice; to invite 2) to give a name to Thayer's Greek Definitions
 - Shepherds call their flocks – Luke 19:13; John 10:3
 - The One who calls has the authority to call – Exo. 33:12-19; Rom. 9:17-18
- Deut. 14:2; Eph. 2:10

❖ God is the One who enables us – Luke 10:19; 2 Cor. 9:8; 1 Tim. 1:12; Phil. 4:13

❖ God is the One who equips us – John 17:17; Eph. 3:20-21; 1 Cor. 1:7; Heb. 13:20-21

❖ God is the One who affirms us – Psa. 23; Deut. 31:8; Isa. 40:27-31

❖ God is the One who redeems us – Eph. 1:7; Tit. 2:14; Col. 1:9-14

❖ God is not intimidated by your past – Isa. 43:18, 25

❖ God is not turned away because of your weakness – 2 Cor. 12:9-10

The One thing in the way of your pivoting to serve:

Part 4: Pivoting to Service (continued)

Things that take us out of service

❖ Opposition

- There is a difference between opposition and constructive feedback
 - Pride will cause you to confuse support with opposition
- Ways we empower our opposition:
 - By entertaining them – Phil. 3:8; Eph. 4:27; Neh. 2:20
 - By promoting them – Luke 4:35
 - Promote: 1. further the progress of (something, especially a cause, venture, or aim); support or actively encourage. 2. advance or raise (someone) to a higher position or rank. Source: Oxford Languages
 - By underestimating them – 2 Corinthians 2:10-11; 1 Pet. 5:8; Eph. 6:11-18
 - By being unprepared for them – 2 Chr. 20:15-17
 - By gratifying them – Rom. 12:17-21; 2 Cor. 10:4

❖ An “It doesn’t take all of that spirit” that says:

- You don’t really have to serve - 1 Pet. 4:10-11; Gal. 6:10
- You don’t have to go to church – Heb. 10:19-27; Eph. 4:12; Heb. 13:17
- They just want to use you – Col. 3:23-24
- It’s not gonna matter – 1 Cor. 15:58

❖ Discouragement

- God hears and will deliver you – Psa. 34:17-19; Isa. 41:10; 1 Pet. 1:3-9 (MSG)

❖ Lost Focus

- Taking focus from Christ – Gal. 5:7; Pro. 16:3; Isa. 26:3
- Taking focus off your assignment and on to others –
- An unfocused mind is more susceptible to the tricks of the enemy – 1 Pet. 5:8

❖ Lack of Support

- 3 Types of support we all need in ministry:
 - Spiritual
 - Physical
 - Emotional

Part 5: Pivoting to Financial Health

5 Keys to Financial Health

❖ Knowledge

➤ Know your Source – GOD – Luke 16:10

➤ Destruction because of a lack of knowledge can be caused by

▪ Lack of awareness

• Biggest tricks of the enemy is to hide truth in front of you

◆ What are you reading and researching? Pro. 18:15

◆ What are you spending your idle time on?

◆ Are you seeking the wisdom of God? James 1:5; Pro. 1:5

◆ What generational barriers are you allowing to operate in your finances?

▪ Lack of reception – Hosea 4:6

• What truths are you rejecting while believing the lies of the enemy? John 8:32

◆ Is tithing biblical? Mal. 3:8-10; Mat. 23:23

◆ Is poverty a sign of deeper walk with Christ? 1 Tim. 6:6-10; Mat. 25:21

◆ Does the church just want my money?

◆ Is there accountability for God's funds?

• Are you teachable? Pro. 1:7

• Do you know how to:

◆ Make a budget? Hab 2:2; 1 Tim 3:5; Pro 6:6-8, 21:5, 21, 20, 23:23, 24:3-4

◆ Invest? Mat. 25:14-30

◆ Sow? 2 Cor. 9:6

◆ Save? Pro. 13:11

◆ Plan? Luke 14:28-30

• Bad information is as bad if not worse than no information – Pro. 15:14;

➤ You must know who you are as a Kingdom citizen – d

▪ Low self esteem can lead to projecting wealth when you are actually broke

▪ When you know who you are, you can be content where God has you – Phil. 4:11-13; 1 Tim. 6:6-12

❖ Faithfulness as a Steward

➤ YOU MUST BE FAITHFUL TO GOD ABOVE ALL THINGS AND NOT MERELY FAITHFUL TO A PROCESS

- Your heart can be in the wrong place while your dollars are in the right place and you won't prosper – 2 Cor. 9:6-8
- We must place Kingdom principles and our witness before mere dollars – Mat. 6:24-25
- Stewards must be Faithful

– "...It is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." 1 Cor. 4:2, KJV

- A steward **never owned** the property or resource he dealt with; he simply managed them for his master and had to manage them faithfully. (Psa 24:1)
- Steward Should Follow God's Financial Plan (Martin Thielen: *God Lessons from the Great Recession: Preaching in the Context of a Financial Downturn*)
 - Earn Ethically (Hab 2:6-9; Pro 11:1)
 - Resist Greed (Ecc 5:10; 1 Tim 6:9-10) also Luke 12:15
 - Spend modestly (1Tim 6:6-8; Heb 13:5)
 - Save Diligently (Pro 21:20; Gen 41:35-36)
 - Give Generously (Pro 3:9; Pro 11:24-25; Act 20:35; 1 Tim 6:18)

❖ Generosity –

- What does the Word say about generosity? Deut. 15:7-8
- God keeps covenant with the generous – Psa. 41:1-3
- Generosity is reciprocated – Luke 6:37-38
- Generosity should be cast abroad – Pro. 11:24-25
- Selfishness is an enemy of generosity – Psa. 119:36
- You don't need seed if you are not going to sow – 2 Cor. 9:10

❖ Obedience –

- We are called to be above and not beneath – Deut. 28:13
- We obey because we love God – John 14:15
- You do not need to apologize for God rewarding your obedience in front of others – Mat. 6:3-4
- PAY YOUR TAXES – Rom. 13:7-8

❖ Spiritual Health –

- Where is your soul? 3 John 2
- Where are your real treasures being stored? Mat. 6:19-21
- Don't get distracted by your financial status – Rev. 3:17

More points to ponder concerning Financial Health

❖ God's Word prospers where He sends it – Isa. 55:11

- That's why it's so important to operate financially in accordance with the Word of God – Mat. 6:33; 3 John 1:2; Gal. 6:9; Pro. 19:17; Pro. 28:22
- God's blessings aren't shady – Pro. 10:22; James 1:17

❖ Financial Health is not measured in mere dollars and cents

- **Are you able and willing to leave what God is calling you away from?**
 - God will often enable you in areas to prepare you for what He has called you to do –
 - Mat. 4:19: Fishers of men
 - Mat. 9:9: The calling of a tax collector
- **Are you able to pursue your calling?**
 - Where are your treasures? Luke 12:34
- **Are you preparing an inheritance? Pro. 13:22**
 - Of spiritual impartation – 2 Tim. 1:5; Pro. 22:6; Deut. 6:5-9
 - Have you taught your seed how to sow and reap? Gen. 8:22; Gal. 6:7; 2 Cor. 9:6
 - Of knowledge & wisdom – Pro. 4:6-7; Pro. 19:20
 - Of work ethic – Col. 3:23-24; Pro. 16:3
 - Of enablement and empowerment – Deut. 3:28

Part 6: Pivoting to Order

Chaos

- ❖ Definition: 1.a. a state of utter confusion; b: a confused mass or mixture
- ❖ God is not the author of Chaos or confusion – 1 Cor. 14:26-33
- ❖ Chaos can indicate a void, emptiness or darkness requires filling – Gen. 1:1-3
- ❖ The presence of chaos is an indicator of the need for God – Pro. 11:14

Order

- ❖ God created us to operate in order – 1 Cor. 1:15-19; 1 Cor. 14:40
- ❖ **Structure:**
 - The world's structure or God's – Rom. 12:2; Mat. 6:33
 - Structures require levels
 - What are you building on? Eph. 2:19-22; Mat. 7: 24-27
 - We run into problems when we don't realize our place in the structure – Eph. 1:22; Col. 1:18
 - Structures can fall when they don't follow the Engineer –
- ❖ There is an order to how the blessings flow – Psa. 133; Psa. 1; Mal. 3:10
- ❖ There is an order in how we worship and exercise gifts – 1 Cor. 14:26-32
 - There is an order in how prophetic giftings flow – 1 Cor. 14:32
- ❖ There is an order in the family – Col. 3:18-21; 1 Tim. 2:1-2; 1 Tim. 3:4; Eph. 6:1-5
- ❖ There is an order in the House of God – 1 Cor. 7:17; 1 Cor. 14:23; Tit. 1:5; Acts 20:28; Acts 13:2; Heb. 13:17

Part 6: Pivoting to Order (continued)

The Blessing of Ordered Steps

- ❖ God sustains you even when you stumble – Psa. 37:23-24; Psa. 121:3
- ❖ God does not hold back the blessing from you – Psa. 84:11; Jos. 1:3
- ❖ You don't have to walk alone – Psa. 32:8

The Attack on Unity

- ❖ The enemy doesn't mind you walking with God so long as you aren't in sync with God – Psa. 119:133
- ❖ Notice that God commands a blessing over your life when we operate in sync with each other and Him – Psa. 133:3
- ❖ The attack on unity in the Body of Christ is really an attack on order – John 17:20-23
- ❖ The enemy knows that great things can be accomplished when we operate in order – Neh. 4:1-13 (vs. 6)
- ❖ When we leave our assignment, we leave order – Jos. 13:33; Deut. 18:1-8; Num. 18: 21-26; 1 Tim. 5:22-24

Order Must be Taught

- ❖ God sustains you even when you stumble – Psa. 37:23-24; Psa. 121:3
- ❖ Authority comes from God – Rom. 13:1-2

Order in Discipleship

- ❖ Love must come first –
 - If we truly want to win souls, we must love
 - Are you concerned about where they are?
 - Are you sharing the truth with them in love?
- ❖ We must plant before we water – 1 Cor. 3:6-8
- ❖ We cannot afford to get in front of God when ministering to others

The Power of Your Thinking

- ❖ Your thoughts about yourself establish you – Pro. 23:7
- ❖ Your thoughts control your mouth – Luke 6:45; Pro. 4:23

The Power of How You See Yourself

- ❖ How you see yourself can determine how others see you – Num. 13:33

What should I set my mind on?

- ❖ High things – Col. 3:2
- ❖ Spiritual things – Rom. 8:5-6
- ❖ How to answer all things from a God perspective – Pro. 15:28 (KJV, MSG)

The Power of How I Believe God Sees Me

- ❖ What is He thinking concerning you – Jer. 29:11
- ❖ What does He want us to have while still here in the earth? – John 14:27
- ❖ You can learn from what He has given you – 2 Tim. 1:7
- ❖ Know what God wants for you – Deut. 30:19

Setting my mind in agreement with God

IT CAN'T BE YOUR WILL ANY LONGER – Luke 22:42, John 18:37

- ➔ OBEDIENCE IS WHERE YOUR WILL MEETS GOD AND SURRENDERS (P.A. Harvin)
- ➔ AGREEMENT IS WHERE HIS WILL BECOMES YOURS (P.A. Harvin) – John 6:38

Submitting My Mind to Christ – HOW?

- ❖ Do you know what are your “ways”?
 - Deut. 11:22 - deh'-rek: a road (as trodden); figuratively a course of life or mode of action, often adverbially: - along, away, because of, + by, conversation, custom (Strong's Hebrew and Greek Dictionary)
 - Psa. 37:4-6 – my course must become His course
 - James 1:8 - hod-os': a road; by implication a progress (the route, act or distance); figuratively a mode or means: - journey, (high-) way.
 - Mat. 6:33; Rom. 14:17; 1 Cor. 4:20
- ❖ I must learn that the battle is for my mind
 - Not a fleshly battle – 2 Cor. 10:1-4
 - What is a stronghold? 2 Cor. 10:5; Eph. 6:14-17
- ❖ You must learn to set your will
 - Psa. 20:7; Psa. 4:8; Psa. 5:3,7; Psa. 7:17; Psa. 34:1

- ❖ I must learn to arrest every thought
 - Examination – Heb. 4:12; 2 Cor. 13:5; Lam. 3:40; Psa. 119:59
 - Motivation – James 4:3; Psa. 1
 - Activation – James 1:20; Phil 1:1-11
- ❖ Identify causes of mind drifts
 - Idleness – Acts 17:21; Ecc. 10:18; Pro. 10:5
 - Unconfessed Sin – Prov. 28:13;
 - Unfulfillment – Num. 14:35; Job 7:1-2; Isa. 55:1-3; Jer. 14:3; Hag. 1:5-6
 - Deception – 1 Cor. 4:7-21
 - Deception from others
 - Bitterness and anger – Eph. 4:31-32
 - Anxiety – Phil. 4:6-7

THE MIND PIVOT – Phil. 3:12-14

- ❖ I'm not there yet (vs. 12)
- ❖ I set myself in the direction I need to go (vs. 12)
- ❖ I forget what I left behind (vs. 13)
- ❖ I reach for what I'm focused on (vs. 13)
- ❖ I press, or push in toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus (vs. 14)

Part 8: The Pivot Strategy

Words to Look Up and Meditate On

Refreshing, Revival, Restoration, Rekindling, Replenishing, Innovate

Strategy requires Structure

- ❖ What systems are lacking around you that are preventing you from realizing the fullness of your calling and purpose?
 - People
 - Resources
 - Motivation
 - Organization
 - Accountability

A Strategic Pivot means a change in process but not a change in promise or vision.

- ❖ Read Hebrews 1:1
 - What did God do with the message?
 - Why?
- ❖ Read Mat. 5:17-20

Strategic Pivots are:

- ❖ Intentional – John 12:32; John 19:28-30
- ❖ Done with preparation
 - God prepares us for pivoting – Mat. 4:19
 - Gen. 50:20
 - Gen. 32:28
 - Esther 4:14
 - We must prepare ourselves and those assigned to us – Neh. 2:11-18
- ❖ Require being open to change -

Questions we must ask ourselves

- ❖ Is what I am doing of God?
- ❖ Is how I am doing it of God?
- ❖ Is my timing of doing it in sync with God?
- ❖ Do I know the goal?
- ❖ Do I have a plan?
